

# HCL Commerce Page Composer Demo – SoFy Environment

## Step 2 : Create a New Layout

1. Go to the Layouts Tab
2. Click Add New Layout
3. Name it “New Home Layout”
4. Set the priority to 10
5. Set the scheduling to start immediately with no expiry date
6. Click Create Layout
7. Double-click the New Homepage Layout tile
8. Select template – Home Page
9. Add widgets



- a. Select each widget one-by-one and configure as follows (use breadcrumbs to go back to each afterwards):

i. Marketing Content

1. Choose “Specify Marketing Content” option
2. Click “Select Content” button
3. Choose “20PercentOffContent” and “DiningRoomHeroContent” content items

ii. Featured Product


1. Choose “Use web activities to recommend a product” option
2. Click “Select Web Activities” button
3. Choose the “Home recommended products” activity

iii. E-Marketing Spot

1. Choose “Common E-Marketing Spot” option
2. Click “Select E-Marketing Spot” button
3. Select “BathHero” marketing spot

### **Step 3 – Assign Page to Layout**

1. Go to the Pages tab under the New Home Layout section



1. Click “Assign pages to this layout” button
2. Select the Home page
3. Select each widget one-by-one and configure as follows (use breadcrumbs to go back to each afterwards):
  - a. Marketing Content
    - i. Choose “Specify Marketing Content” option
    - ii. Click “Select Content” button
    - iii. Choose “20PercentOffContent” and “DiningRoomHeroContent” content items
  - b. Featured Product
  - c. Choose “Use web activities to recommend a product” option
  - d. Click “Select Web Activities” button
    - i. Choose the “Home recommended products” activity
  - e. iii. E-Marketing Spot
    - i. Choose “Common E-Marketing Spot” option
    - ii. Click “Select E-Marketing Spot” button
    - iii. Select “BathHero” marketing spot

### **Step 4 – Preview the New Page**

1. Go back to the main Pages tab
2. Double click on the “NewHome” page
3. Click the Preview button
4. Test your new page with the various viewport and device orientation options
